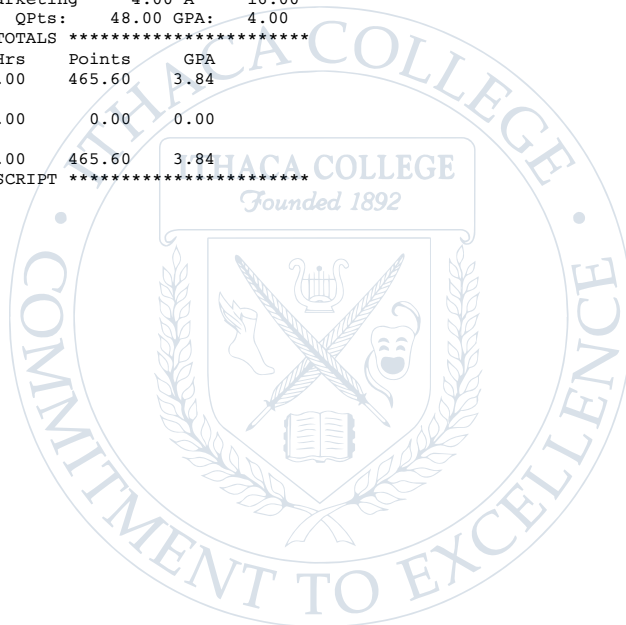

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KEY TO TRANSCRIPT EVALUATION

CALENDAR SYSTEM

Ithaca College currently uses the semester system. Each semester is 15 weeks in length, including the final examination week. Summer sessions vary in length but sufficient instruction is provided to equate semester hours earned to those of the academic year.

Credit is earned on a semester-hour basis.

Class periods consist of 50-minute periods that meet 3 times per week, 75-minute periods that meet 2 times per week, or seminars that meet from 1 to 3 hours per week, depending on the number of semester hours being offered.
